



COVID-19 Update

June 9, 2020 COVID-19 UPDATE Premier Ford announced June 8, 2020 Phase 2 reopening.

Phase 2 allows Fishing Guides and Charter operators to resume operations in Ontario effective Friday June 12 at 12:01AM, **with the following EXCEPTIONS**. Durham, Halton, Hamilton, Haldimand-Norfolk, Lambton, Niagara, Peel, Toronto, Windsor-Essex and York. You can not operate in these areas at this time.

- The Premier will update the status of the exception areas every Monday.
- Groups will increase from 5 to 10 people (including crew), June 12 at 12.01AM

Safety Guidelines and Recommendations for Operating

- 1) Maintain a log with date, customer's names, addresses and contact info for each trip.
- 2) Ask customer's if they have been ill or had symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 2 weeks before allowing them to board. Any customers or crew with symptoms must be denied boarding. Hand held thermometers are available for \$100.00 to check customers and crew's temperatures before allowing them to board.
- 3) Social distancing of 6 feet (2 meters) must be maintained. If social distancing can not be continuously maintained, face protection should be worn by customer's and crew.
- 4) No more than 10 people including crew on board at any time.
- 5) Hand sanitizing stations on board.
- 6) Cleaning/Disinfecting protocol carried out under the supervision of the captain. Independent log should be maintained.
- 7) Signage listing symptoms of COVID-19 should be displayed on board.
- 8) Washrooms shall be well stocked with handwashing supplies, hand sanitizer and paper towels. (no cloth towels)
- 9) Assure frequent cleaning of high touch surfaces, rods and reels.

DIY Suggestions for Cleaning Solutions

Hard Surface Cleaner:

- 1/3 cup bleach in 1 gallon of room temperature water
- Put in spray bottles to use.

Sanitizer Spray for Hands and surfaces:

- 1 cup Isopropyl alcohol. CDC minimum allowable of isopropyl is 70%. The higher % the better.
- 1 tablespoon of hydrogen peroxide
- 2 teaspoons of vegetable glycerin or aloe vera gel (pharmacy or health food stores)
- 1 tablespoon of water
- mix together well and pour into plastic spray bottles (Dollar store)
- ** it will be thinner than store bought product but just as effective.
